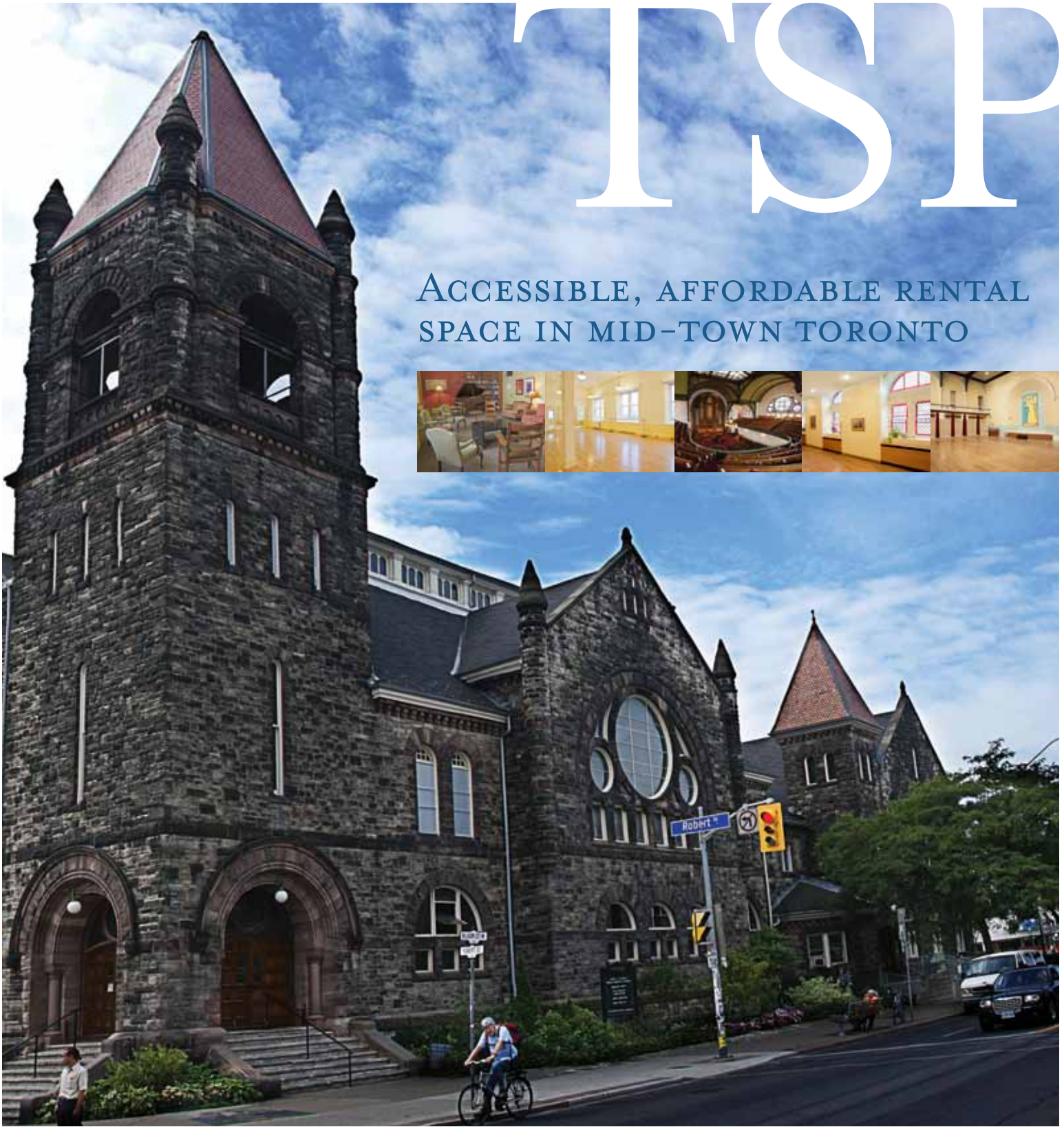

Trinity-St. Paul's (TSP) Centre for Faith, Justice and the Arts is a community hub in mid-town Toronto that has been serving the local and extended neighbourhood for more than 125 years. Today, we're home to 60 organizations – cultural, educational, religious, recreational, community and social service groups.

Special feature	Sprung hardwood floor, mirrored wall, access to industrial kitchen





MUSIC ROOM • CHAPEL

A flexible space that works well for meetings of all types and as rehearsal space for drama, singing and musical groups.

Serves as a support room (green room) for Performance Hall. Linked to a small kitchen.*
